In our last Purchase Pulse, I told you about the terrific job you did in exceeding our District Pledge to Mission. Once again, many thanks for your generosity. You will be glad to hear that our TWK Conference UWF also had a tremendous year of giving. We, as a Conference, also exceeded our pledge of \$120,000, by sending in a whopping \$203,247.55 to support missions and ministries for women, children, and youth around the world. I hope you are proud of this success and will continue to work to make 2023 another year of generous giving.

So, how are we as a district doing so far in 2023. I have just sent in our second quarter remittance, for a total of \$8,332.66 in undesignated giving and \$1,035 for Call to Prayer and Self Denial.
